# What is ENGR489?

#### **Individual Engineering Project**

- The ENGR489 project course consists of an individual project done under the supervision of one (or more) academic staff.
- Individual projects with a similar theme and same supervisor(s) may be collated together as a 'group project'
  - Still marked individually



# **Project Allocation (1)**

 Project Allocation System (PAS) is used by both staff and students to register and rank projects

https://ecs.wgtn.ac.nz/apps/projectselection

- Algorithm used for matching students to staff and projects is a variation on the Deferred Acceptance Algorithm (DAA)
  - DAA produces stable matches and is strategy proof
  - Trying to mislead the system about your rankings (e.g., to try and get a better allocation) will only lead to you getting a worse outcome

# **Project Allocation (2)**


- Students cannot pick more than two projects (excluding the industry projects) from any given (primary) supervisor
- Students must rank at least seven different projects
- Staff rank the student-project selections
- Privacy: staff cannot see student ranking
- Some projects have co-supervisors listed
- Industry projects: projects proposed by external entities/companies
  - A student can pick as many industry projects from a supervisor and are not counted as part of "maximum of two projects" constraint discussed above.
  - Requires external collaboration agreement (ECA) to be signed
